- 2. Do you think any of his excuses were justified? Why or why not?**

- 4. Moses had a great fear of going back to Egypt. What are some of our fears in ministry? How can we overcome them?**
- 5. Do we fear the wicked people of this world?**
- 6. Is there someone that you feel does not deserve Gods forgiveness? If so, what should we do when we feel this way?**
- 7. Why was Jonah angry that the Ninevites repented ?(Jonah 4:1-2)**
- 8. Are there things God is calling you to do, that you don't want to do or are just refusing to do?**
- 9. What stands out to you the most about Isaiah's vision in Isaiah 6:1-8?**
- 10. Do we realize our own sinfulness and remember what Christ has done for us? What should this cause us to do?**

**Isaiah 6: 1-8 (ASV)**

**1** In the year that king Uzziah died I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up; and his train filled the temple. **2** Above him stood the seraphim: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. **3** And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is Jehovah of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory. **4** And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke. **5** Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, Jehovah of hosts.

**6** Then flew one of the seraphim unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: **7** and he touched my mouth with it, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin forgiven. **8** And I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then I said, Here am I; send me.

**Exodus 3:4 (NIV)**

**4** When the Lord saw that he had gone over to look, God called to him from within the bush, "Moses! Moses!"

And Moses said, "Here I am.

**Exodus 4:13 (NIV)**

**13** But Moses said, "Pardon your servant, Lord. Please send someone else.

**Jonah 1:2, 3 (Asv)**

**1 2** Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me. **3** But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of Jehovah; and he went down to Joppa, and found a ship going to Tarshish: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of Jehovah.
